Northern Roots Circular Walk

Meadow route

A circular route through Snipe Clough to Park Bridge Heritage Centre. **Approximately 2.8 miles.**

- 1. From the car park at the bottom of Kings Road/ Honeywell Lane, head in a north easterly direction for 50m, turn right onto the playing field.
- At the bottom of the field cut through the narrow path entering the woodland.
- 3. Bear left, down the steps, keep left passing the heron pond. Continue through the woodland until you reach a stone pathway. Turn right onto the path.
- Turn left, continuing along the pathway, through the meadow.
- 5. As you approach a Y ahead, turn right into the woodland.

Suitable for...

People steady on their feet. A mix of paved and muddy paths, some steps and some steep woodland slopes. **Walking boots recommended**

- 6. Continue until you arrive at a signpost and turn left in the direction of Park Bridge. Pass through the gate until you arrive at the edge of Snipe Clough, turn left.
- 7. Walk along Dingle Terrace bearing right onto Tuns Road, passing Park Bridge Heritage Centre.
- 8. Before you reach the chimney, turn right along the stone path, through the kissing gate.
- Head up the steps in front of you. When you reach the top, turn right. Continue to bear right, passing the gate until you reach the sign post.
- Head in the direction of Alexandra Park until you arrive back at the car park.
